Location:

Situated on a private peninsula in Governador Celso Ramos, approximately 50 km north of Florianópolis, Awasi Santa Catarina is surrounded by the green waters of the Emerald Coast. A natural preservation area, marked by the exuberance of the Atlantic Forest and small coves, forms the ideal setting for days of disconnection, well-being and contemplation of nature. The lodge faces the Três Ilhas archipelago and is protected by a peaceful bay, ideal for nautical activities and moments of total serenity.

How to get there:

The nearest airport is Florianópolis International Airport – Hercílio Luz (FLN), with daily flights from the main Brazilian capitals and international connections via São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro. The journey to the lodge takes around 1h15 by road. It is also possible to organize private transfers or arrival by helicopter upon request.

A brief story

Open in 2001, the lodge was born from the desire to offer truly Brazilian hospitality, in balance with nature and with a focus on privacy and excellence. Located on a private peninsula, surrounded by the Atlantic Forest and bathed by the calm waters of the Costa Smeralda, it has become, over the years, one of the main destinations for refuge, break and celebration.

With just 25 villas spread across more than 80,000 m², the hotel has built its reputation based on personalized experiences, attentive service and cuisine that values local ingredients and traditions.

The privileged location, approximately 50 km from Florianópolis, in Governador Celso Ramos, connects guests to an authentic cultural heritage, while offering comfort, exclusivity and tranquility amid nature.



Our Lodge

Awasi Santa Catarina has 25 private villas set in the natural landscape of the peninsula. All have a heated pool with sea views. Some units offer a sauna and even a private gym. Furthermore, the lodge has two courts – tennis and beach tennis –, a Wellness Center with sea views and two restaurants, one of which is the Veleza space where we have a grill.

In addition, guests have access to a private island where it is possible to organize dinners and small events, as well as trails throughout the property that connect guests to nature

She lived in France, where she worked at Michel Guérard's Michelin-starred Les Prés d'Eugénie, and studied in San Sebastián, Spain, and the Bologna region of Italy.

Wellness Center

The Wellness Center sits within the Atlantic Forest, overlooking the Costa Esmeralda.

Two menus set the tone, Sea and Forest, each bringing together massages, bodywork, hair rituals and practices inspired by the landscape around us. The multiuse studio hosts yoga, tatami treatments and additional therapies on demand. At the Alchemy Atelier, guests mix herbal infusions, blends and natural masks, while soaking baths round out the experience.

The thermal circuit at Awasi draws on ancient Eastern and European practices, using thermal contrasts to awaken the circulatory, immune and nervous systems while inviting profound relaxation.

The experience unfolds in three stages: hot ofurô, igniting vital energy; cold ofurô, sharpening the senses; and warm ofurô, restoring balance to the body.

Weather

The climate is humid subtropical, with hot summers and mild winters. the region can be visited all year round, and each season offers a different landscape and proposal.

Average Temperatures

In summer (December to March):
Average temperatures are between 25°C and 32°C, ideal for enjoying the sea and nature.

In autumn (April to June):
The weather is pleasant and drier, great for hiking.

In winter (July to September):
We have sunnier days.

In spring (October and November):
Nature is more exuberant.

What to pack

We recommend bringing lightweight, breathable clothing, a swimsuit, and hiking shoes.

Other items include:
Sunglasses, sunscreen, insect repellent, a hiking backpack, and any medications you may need.
